Oras Group, as a downstream trader, manufacturer, and distributor of sanitary products and bathroom furniture, is fully committed to complying with the requirements of the **EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR) (EU) 2023/1115**, including its 2026 update.

All wood-based materials incorporated into our products — such as cardboard packaging, paper manuals, and wooden components sourced by our furniture manufacturers — originate from **certified European suppliers** who have demonstrated full compliance with EUDR obligations. These suppliers provide Due Diligence Statements (DDS) submitted to the EU Information System (TRACES), including risk assessments, traceability documentation, and verification numbers.

As a **downstream trader and manufacturer**, Oras Group does not harvest or first place any relevant wood commodities on the EU market; rather, we rely on our upstream partners to ensure that materials used are **legally harvested, deforestation-free**, and obtained in accordance with applicable legislation – including environmental, labor, and human rights standards.

Our compliance system is supported by **supplier declarations, third-party certifications, and internal audits**. Packaging and manuals are solely used to protect and accompany our products and are not marketed as standalone items.

Oras Group does not sell any products that consist of natural rubber, under any of its brands.

We continuously monitor updates to the EUDR and related EU legislation to ensure ongoing compliance and to uphold the highest standards of environmental and social responsibility.
