



Compliance with EU Conflict Minerals Regulation 2017/821

Oras Group is committed to responsible business practices and ethical sourcing throughout our supply chain.

The EU Regulation 2017/821 on conflict minerals establishes due diligence obligations for EU importers of tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold (3TG) when these minerals are imported above defined annual volume thresholds. The Regulation's requirements are aimed at importers of raw materials and smelters/refiners, ensuring responsible sourcing from conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

As a manufacturer of faucets and related finished products, Oras Group is **not an importer of raw 3TG minerals and therefore is not directly subject to the EU Conflict Minerals Regulation**. Nevertheless, we recognize that some of our customers may have due diligence obligations under this Regulation and related corporate policies.

To support our customers, we engage with our suppliers to ensure transparency within the supply chain and to promote responsible sourcing practices. Based on the information available to us, our products are not designed to intentionally contain tin, tantalum, tungsten, or gold.

We remain committed to cooperating with our partners to improve supply chain transparency and to support responsible sourcing initiatives.
