Compliance with REACH legislation

Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006

The purpose of the REACH regulation, in force since June 2007, is to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment. Under REACH, Oras Group is classified as a downstream user and is not obliged to register its products.

Oras Group has evaluated the requirements of REACH and, to the best of its knowledge, meets the obligations applicable to it as a downstream user. We actively follow the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) candidate list published by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) and adapt our chemical-usage principles as needed.

Under Article 33, a manufacturer must give customers sufficient information on any SVHC present above 0.1% by weight in a product, to allow its safe use. The use of such substances is not always avoidable; where present, we inform accordingly. For example:

- **Lead** (CAS 7439-92-1 / EC 231-100-4) can be present in products made with brass components.
- **1,2-dimethoxyethane (EGDME)** (CAS 110-71-4 / EC 203-794-9) can be present in electronic products as a constituent of lithium batteries.

For specific material data, please refer to the material declaration of the product in question. When used as intended, the product is safe to use; please observe the product's instruction manual or the documents provided electronically.

We further declare that products under Oras Group brands:

- comply with the **PAH** (Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons) restriction of REACH Annex XVII (entry 50, Regulation (EU) No 1272/2013);
- do not carry **antimicrobial surface treatments** on the product surfaces.

We furthermore declare that products of Oras Group with electrical and electronic components conform to European Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS-II), including amendment (EU) 2015/863 (RoHS 3), where applicable relying on the exemptions in its Annexes (for example for lead in certain copper alloys), which are time-limited and subject to renewal.

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
